**OPEN HOUSE SET ON CROWN POINT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

The public is invited to an open house Thursday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 regarding the Crown Point Improvement Project. The meeting is from 5:30-7:00 pm at Northwest High School Auditorium, 8204 Crown Point Avenue.

A brief presentation beginning at 5:45 will provide attendees with an overview of the project and concepts for roadway alternatives for Crown Point Avenue from 72<sup>nd</sup> Street to Blair High Road. Attendees will have the opportunity to offer feedback on several roadway alternatives. The consultant team and City staff will be on hand to share information about the project.

Attendees should enter the parking lot using the east driveway into Northwest High School, and enter through the southeast door.

The purpose of the project is to replace the pavement on Crown Point Avenue, upgrade the sidewalks and curb ramps to meet current standards, and repurpose the existing width of the road to accommodate multiple modes of transportation. This project will also incorporate principles from Omaha's Complete Streets policy.

Where possible, an accessible meeting facility for disabled persons will be provided. Appropriate provisions for the hearing and visually impaired persons will be made if the City of Omaha is notified by August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
