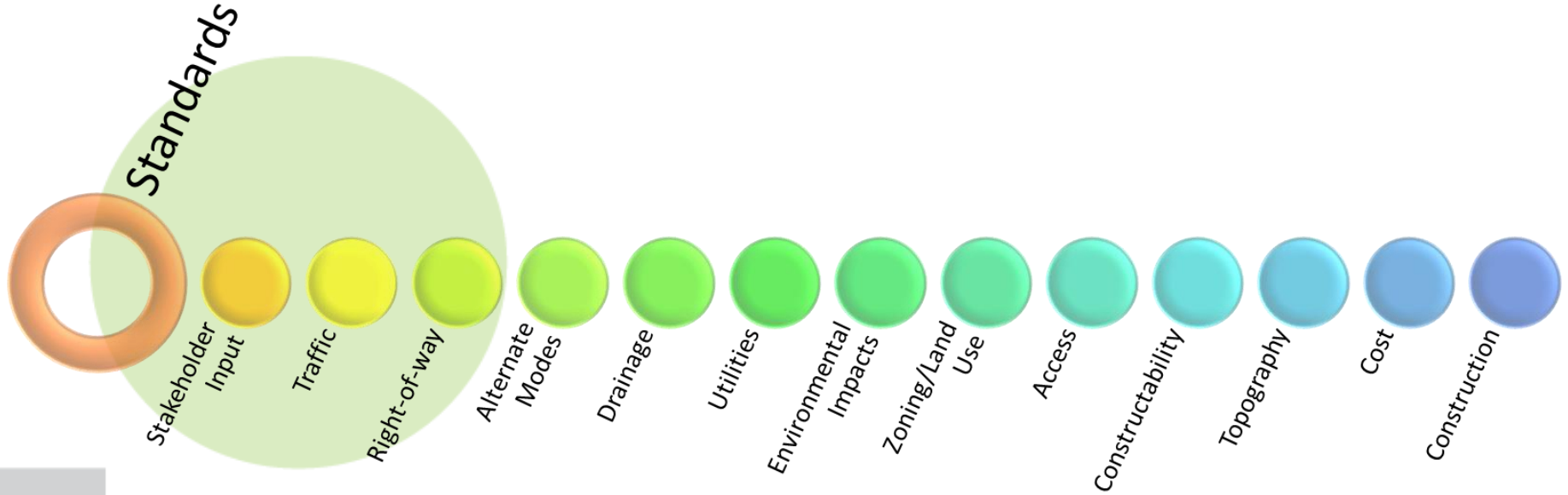

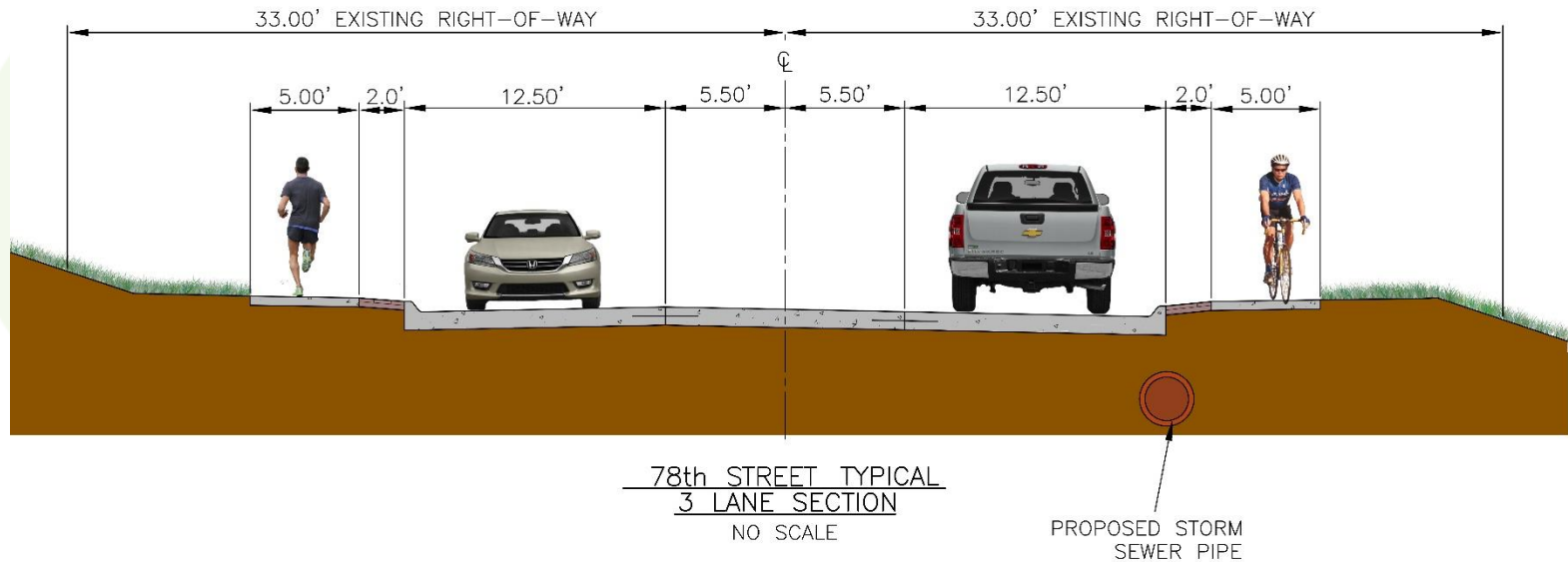

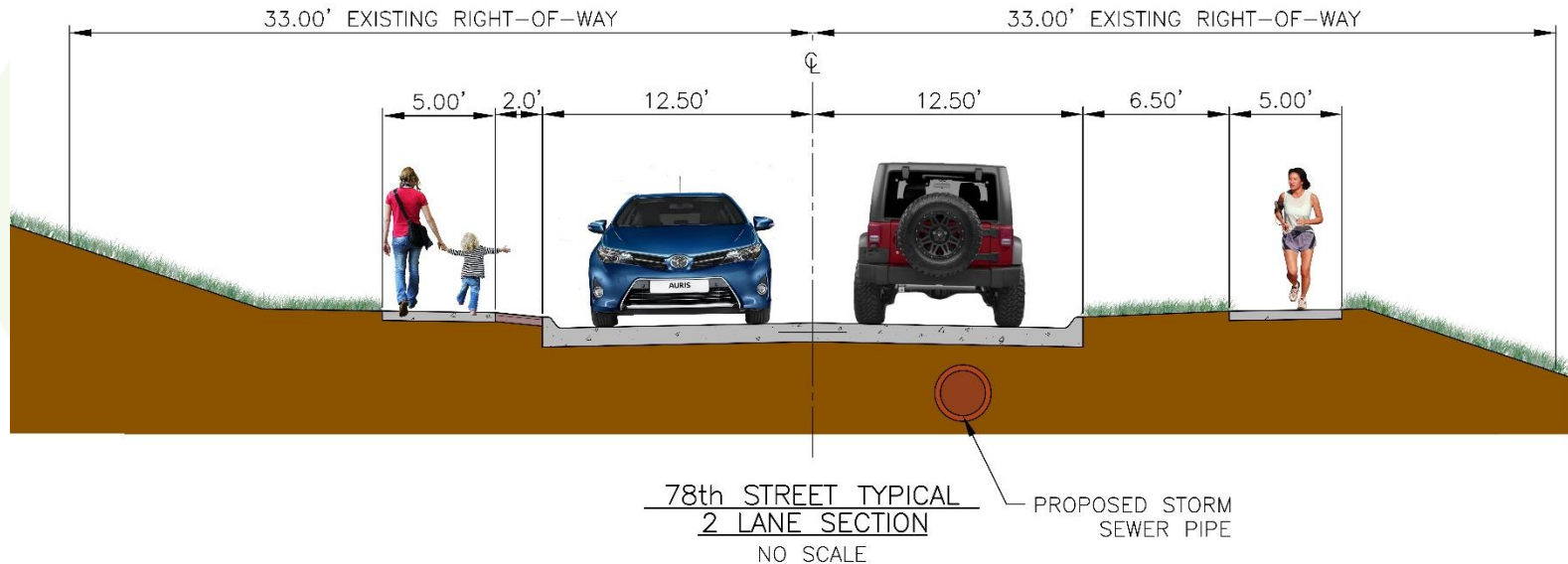

3-LANE CROSS SECTION



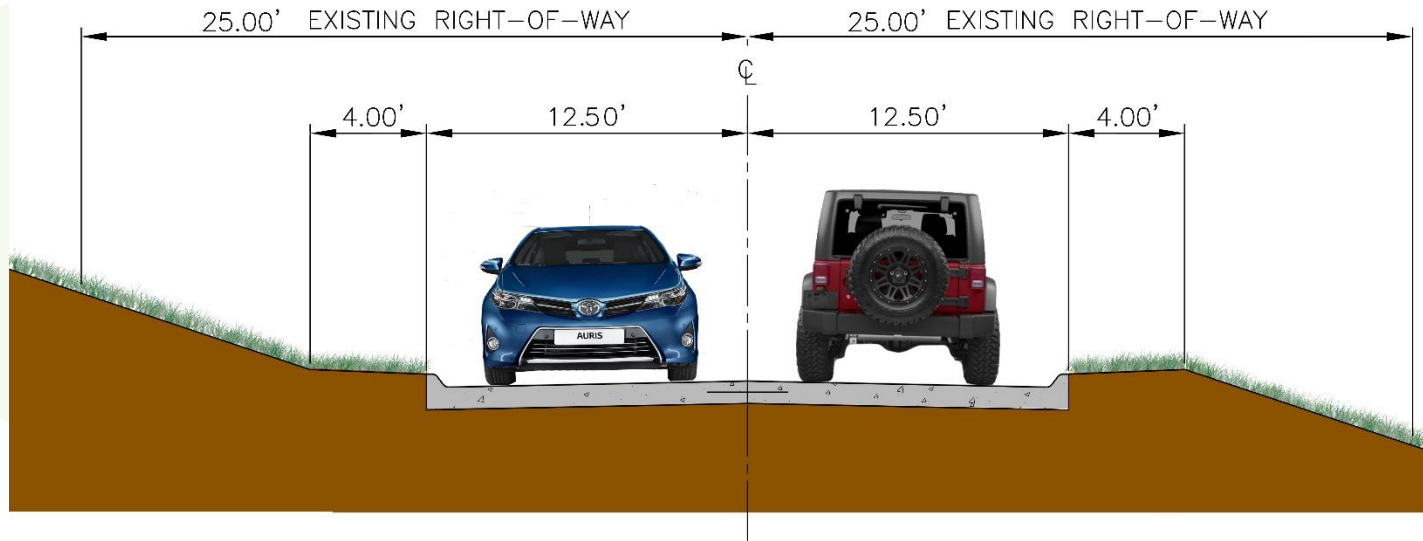

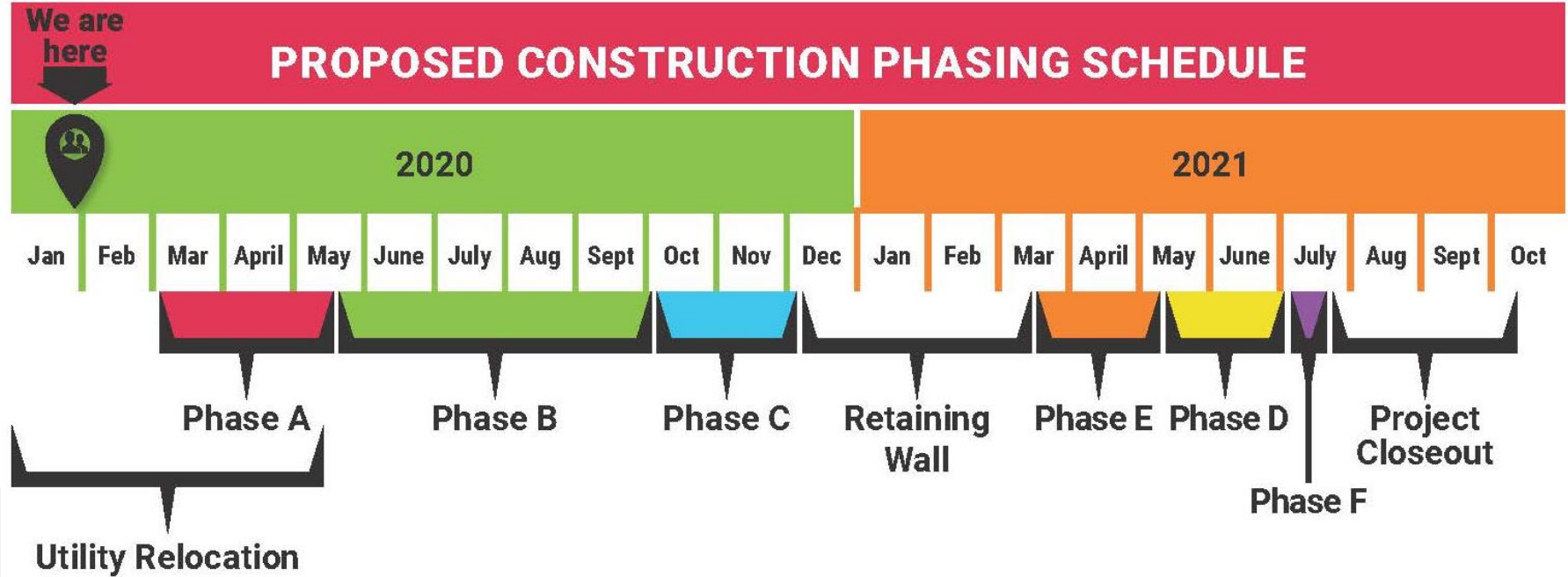

OVERALL PHASING AREAS

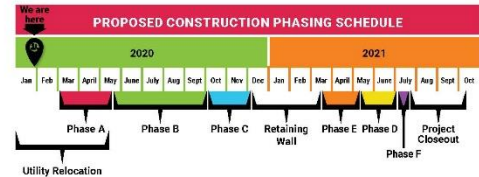

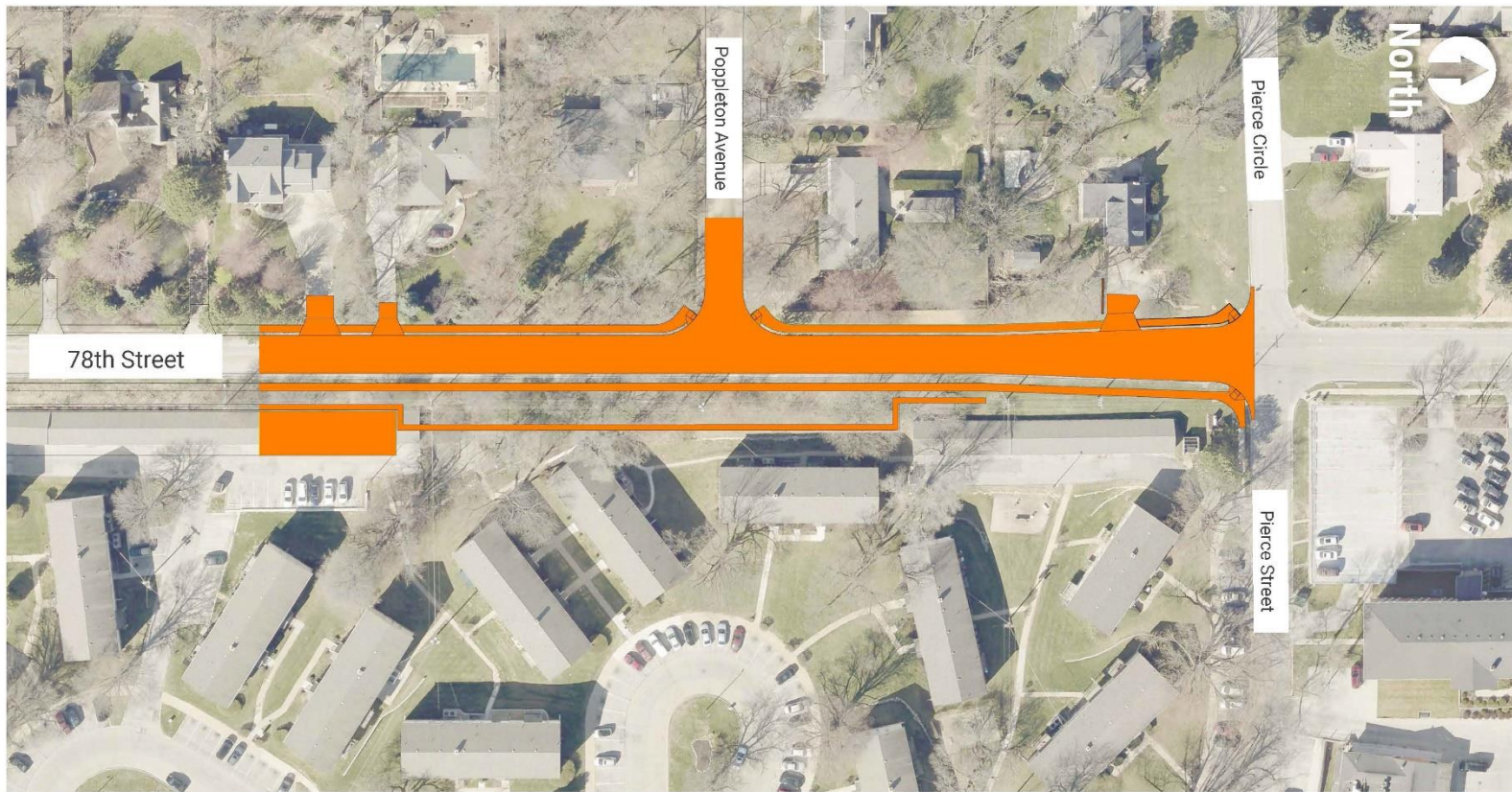

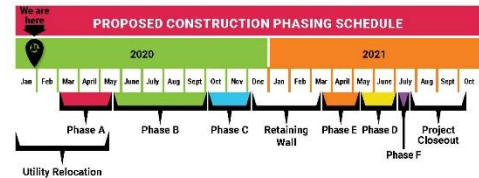

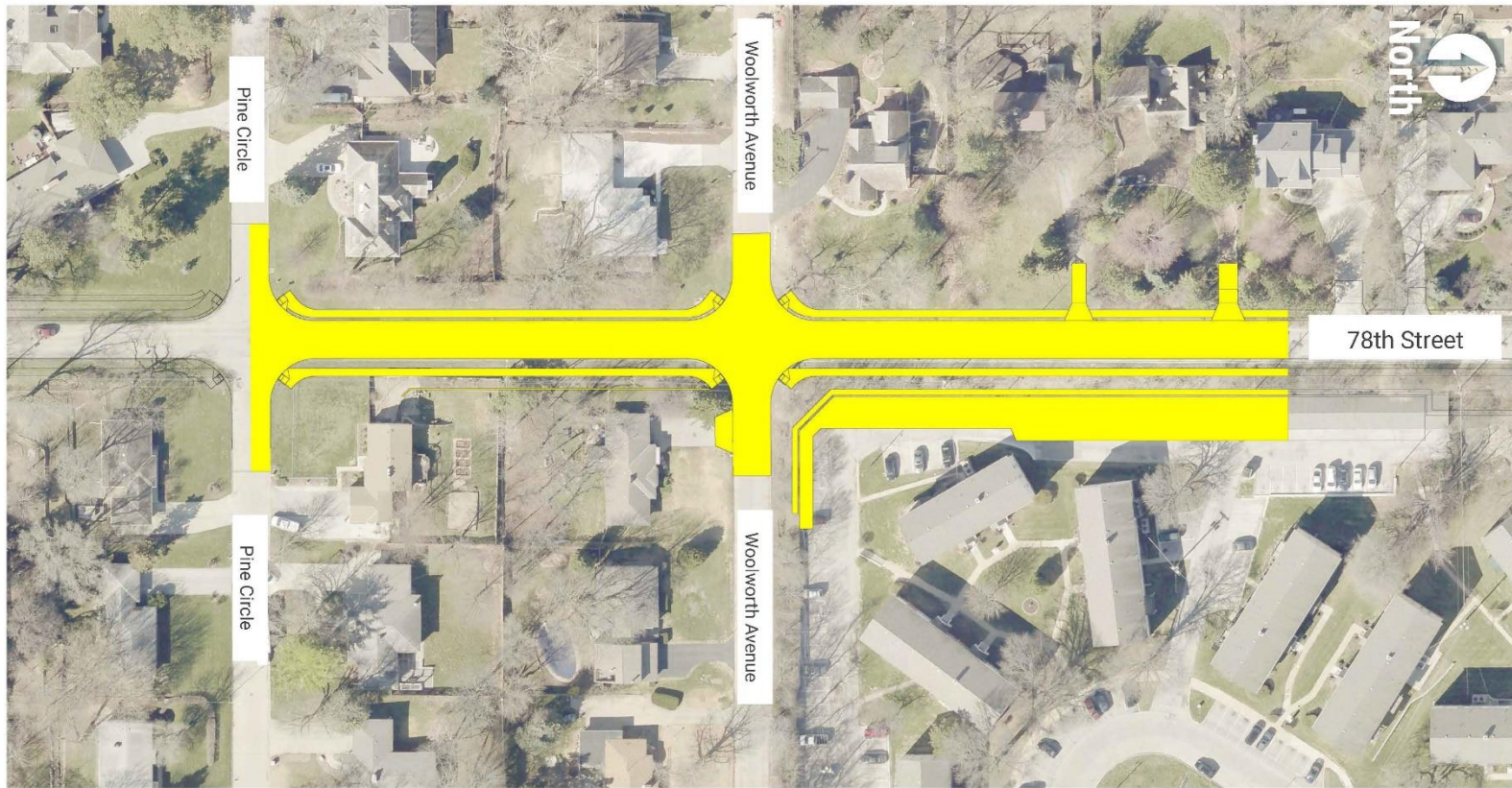

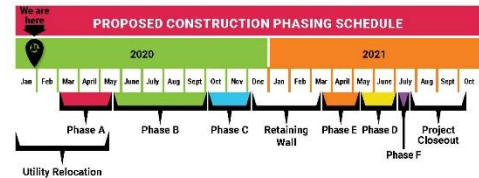

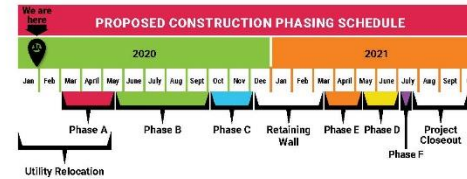
