168th STREET WEST CENTER RD. TO PACIFIC ST. CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

RE: Late Night Sawing Operations

Dear Property Owner or Tenant,

This notice is to inform you the City of Omaha has contracted with Charles Vrana Construction Company for the improvement of 168th Street from West Center Rd. to Pacific St. The City has retained Olsson to provide construction engineering services during the project. Periodically throughout the project, contractors will construct new concrete pavement during the daytime hours. To improve the quality and longevity of the concrete pavement, it is necessary to saw-cut joints into the new pavement. The timeframe for cutting these joints into the pavement is very limited. While the workers will make every effort to complete this work by 9:00 PM., there will be times when this is not possible, and the work may need to continue into the night hours.

Please be advised the City has authorized the contractors to continue saw-cutting until all joints have been sawed even if this operation extends into nighttime hours. The City has asked that workers endeavor to complete this work as quickly as possible to minimize any late-night disturbances. While we anticipate some late-night sawing will be necessary, it is expected to only occur periodically throughout this construction season and primarily when long stretches of pavement are constructed. We are sorry for the inconvenience, but this is necessary to ensure a rapid completion of the project and quality construction.
