


































24th Street Complete Street Safety Project

Enhance Safety



Improve Multimodal Connectivity

The 24th Street Complete Street Safety
Project is located on 24th Street, from
Leavenworth Street to U.S. Highway 275.
To improve safety while maintaining
acceptable traffic operations, this project
would reconfigure 24th Street from a four-lane
roadway to a three-lane roadway with center
turn lane and a bike lane in each direction.

(Widen roadway 4-5 feet to the East)

(Eliminate Parking and Restripe)





The US-275, 25th-23rd Street Project is located on US-275 / L Street, starting just west of the US-75 Kennedy Freeway northbound off-ramp and extending east to approximately the intersection of US-275 / L Street and 23rd street.

This project would add dual left turn lanes on US-275 / L Street for eastbound to northbound traffic.


