Dear Resident:

At this time, Phase B work that began in mid-May along 78th Street from just south of Shirley Street to Hickory Circle is beginning to wrap-up outside of grading, sidewalk installation, and seeding. The stretch is anticipated to be opened back up to local traffic **ONLY** beginning August 19, weather pending. The area will also continue to have workers and equipment present until work is completed over the next few weeks. We ask that you take caution when driving thru the work zone.

Phase C work involving the stretch along 78th Street from Hickory Circle to Pine Circle is scheduled to close and begin on/around August 19th weather pending. This work will also include the intersection tie-ins to 78th Street at Hickory Street and at Pine Circle.

If your driveway is affected by this phase of work, **please** make arrangements to have your car removed from your garage/drive if it is a vehicle you intend to use during the course of construction. As items of work are completed, you will then be allowed to access your drive once again.

As mentioned in our resident notice delivered earlier this year, all construction improvements include the replacement of the aging asphalt 2-lane roadway with a new concrete 2-lane roadway with sidewalks, storm sewers, water main, driveways, retaining walls, and upgrades associated with utilities along the corridor. These improvements will affect private properties both sides of the roadway. As with all roadway construction activities, this work may cause an inconvenience to you.

Please do not move or otherwise tamper with temporary fencing, barricades or other warning devices. They are essential for identifying potentially unsafe conditions. If applicable, please advise others (**including children**) at your location of the upcoming work and the need to exercise due care when in areas near or adjacent to the construction areas and activities. To help minimize delays in completing the work, please do not activate any lawn sprinklers that may spray water into the construction area.
