
Coordination with Fort Street

Fort Street from 120th Street to 126th Street will be widened to a four-lane divided roadway and the bridge over Big Papillion Creek will be reconstructed. Fort Street and Tranquility Park will be coordinated and constructed concurrently. A future project will widen Fort Street from 126th Street to 132nd Street.

Coordination Elements

- Fort Street access to Tranquility Park and Kelly Fields
- Pedestrian and trail access at Fort Street
- Construction staging to limit disruption











Fort Street Roadway Improvements

Project Description

This project will improve traffic operations and safety for all transportation users by reconstructing this segment of Fort Street to a four-lane divided roadway with a raised median to separate driving lanes and provide left-turn accommodation, where necessary. The project will also include replacement of the Big Papillion Creek bridge, urban storm sewers, sidewalks, ADA curb ramps, a multi-use path, and pavement repairs in the area of 120th Street.

Phase 1 will include reconstruction of Fort Street from 126th Street to 120th Street in coordination with the Tranquility Redevelopment. A traffic signal will be installed at Tranquility Drive. A closure of Fort Street for approximately nine months is proposed to reduce construction duration.

Project Purpose & Need

Improve capacity, safety, and add pedestrian facilities.

Project Benefits

Replace an aging two-lane roadway that is beyond its serviceable life.









Fort Street Project Schedule

- The Fort Street, 126th Street to Park Entrance Road, project is currently in the final design phase.
- Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in June 2026.
- Fort Street will be closed to through traffic during construction, but local access will be maintained to the Kelly Baseball Fields and 122nd Court.
