Dear Resident and business owners:

The City of Omaha would like to take this opportunity to update you of one final lane configuration change upcoming that will affect your residence/business on the final portion of the 108<sup>th</sup> Street project from Decatur Street to Mill Valley Road. This final step will involve some minor ingress/egress changes to your everyday route to the south 108<sup>th</sup> Circle area so that the contractor can build out the final paving portion of the roundabout work near 108<sup>th</sup> & Burt Street.

Beginning Monday July 29, the traffic flow in your affected area will be rerouted and will last 4 days. Residents and business that reside roughly south of 108<sup>th</sup> & Burt Street, or along S. 108<sup>th</sup> Circle, will be directed through the new roundabout and to the north exclusively to exit and enter the area. Attached is a detailed map that shows the traffic pattern for this small amount of time.

Shortly after the completion of this work, all traffic will then be opened up fully to the public and the project itself will be drawing to a close. With that being said, there will be minor construction cleanup activities outside of the roadway areas over the next few weeks to follow but should not affect traffic in any major way going forward.

As always, please do not move or otherwise tamper with temporary fencing, barricades or other warning devices. They are essential for identifying potentially unsafe conditions. If applicable, please advise others **(including children)** at your location of the upcoming work and the need to exercise due care when in areas near or adjacent to the construction areas and activities. To help minimize delays in completing the work, please do not activate any lawn sprinklers that may spray water into the construction area.
