# TRAFFIC VOLUMES


## Current Volumes

- 156<sup>th</sup> Street Daily Traffic
  - 20,000-24,000 Vehicles/day
    - 20,000 Vehicles/Day at Fort Street
    - 24,000 Vehicles/Day at W Maple Road

## 2050 Volumes

- 156<sup>th</sup> Street Daily Traffic
  - 37,000-44,000 Vehicles/Day
    - 37,000 Vehicles/Day at Fort Street
    - 44,000 Vehicles/Day at W Maple Road



# ALTERNATIVE CONCEPTS – INTERSECTION CONTROL ON 156<sup>TH</sup> STREET

- Common Intersections
  - Traffic Signals
  - Unsignalized
  - Limited Access
- Roundabouts
  - Utilize RRFB Pedestrian Signals across 156<sup>th</sup> Street



# ALTERNATIVE CONCEPTS – SPAULDING STREET /SPAULDING PLAZA



- Known Crash History
  - Northbound Left
    - Maple traffic backs up to this intersection blocking vision
- $\frac{3}{4}$  Limited Access
  - Allows Southbound Left into Commercial Zone




